2018 will be the first European Year of Cultural Heritage and we have decided to dedicate our Creative Writing Competition to this event. The main aims are to promote cultural diversity, intercultural dialogue and social cohesion, to emphasize the role of cultural heritage, to highlight our common European identity.

The competition, which is aimed at students of primary, middle and secondary schools including students with special educational needs and learning difficulties, encourages creativity and self-expression, helps develop autonomy as well as cross-curricular skills and presentation skills. Also it gives the opportunity to develop CLIL connections.

In this workshop we will provide the teachers with ideas, resources and examples to develop in the classroom. The main idea is to help students become aware of European history and values and to draw attention to the opportunities offered by our cultural heritage and to the challenges it has to face for the future like the digital shift, environmental and physical pressure on heritage sites.

Maglione is a teacher of English language and culture at Liceo Scientifico ‘Teresa Gullace Talotta’ in Rome, a former training supervisor at SSIS Lazio, a TFA teacher trainer at the University of Rome, ‘Tor Vergata’.
