The seminar is focused on how creativity is what has propelled us forward as a species – it expands our world and brings us new ideas, inventions and discoveries. Creativity is the act of turning new and imaginative ideas into reality. Furthermore, in the revised Bloom's taxonomy "creating" is on top of the pyramid and in the framework for 21<sup>st</sup> century learning is among the skills students need to succeed in work, life and citizenship. In the seminar we will reflect on how to encourage students to develop their creativity and engage them in meaningful activities.

The creative writing competition, which is aimed at students of primary, middle and secondary schools including students with special educational needs and learning difficulties, encourages creativity and self-expression, helps develop autonomy as well as cross-curricular skills and presentation skills. Also it gives the opportunity to develop CLIL connections.

M.G. Maglione is a teacher of English language and culture at Liceo 'Teresa Gullace Talotta' in Rome, a former training supervisor at SSIS Lazio, a TFA teacher trainer at the University of Rome, 'Tor Vergata'. She has taken part in the Action Research Project and in several multimedia projects. She is TESOL Italy First Vice-President.

M.A. Ortenzi is the coordinator of the local group in Rome. She is a TESOL Italy Executive Committee member. She was a teacher at Liceo Scientifico 'Primo Levi' in Rome, was responsible for language certifications in her school and she was involved in the Action Research project.

E. Vaccaro, teacher of English language and culture at Liceo "Teresa Gullace Talotta", vicedirector of NEU (Nuova Editrice Universitaria), member of Rome TESO Group and of TESOL Italy Executive Committee, holds a PhD in English Literature and has written books on motivation, CLIL and Tourism Management.
