The symposium aims to shine fresh light on aspects related to teaching English as a third language. The symposium features a keynote speech and a series of talks on issues pertinent to third language acquisition and teaching English as an L3. Holistic perspectives on additional language learning and teaching are presented and discussed in light of new research. The focus is on integrated multilingual approaches to language(s) learning and teaching. Key notions such as meta- and crosslinguistic awareness and multilingual competences are examined with a view to instructional practices in the classroom, and directions for future developments are provided.
